INFORMATION LETTER/UPDATE:

I have been approached for over three years by civilians in the community who request that I teach civilian marksmanship courses for self-defense. I have resisted, but after giving it much thought, I have decided to test the waters and teach a few civilian marksmanship courses. This will be only done on a flat range and will not encompass tactics.

A great deal of my decision deals with safety and the civilian. Having obtained a concealed weapon permit (CCW) in the state of Texas, I am well aware of the lack of training most students receive when attending the mandatory CCW classes. The shooting phase of the class is more of a “pray no one shoots themselves or another student” and then get them off the range with their certificate. I want to provide follow on training for the individuals who want to safely carry and surgically employ a firearm.

Listed below are course I intend to instruct.

CIVILIAN COURSES:

- **Advanced Concealed Carry**
- **Tactical Pistol**
- **Tactical Rifle**
- **Tactical Pistol/Rifle**

ADVANCED CONCEALED CARRY (2 Days)

This course will be structured similar to the tactical pistol class, but it will focus on safe employment from the concealed carry holster or fanny pack.

TACTICAL PISTOL (2 Days)

This is my basic handgun course which will introduce the student to a stair-stepped shooting and training program that will allow students to self-evaluate their skills and focus on areas of weakness. Safe handgun manipulation will be engrained into the student.

TACTICAL RIFLE (2 Days)

This is my basic rifle course which will introduce the student to a stair-stepped shooting and training program that will allow students to self-evaluate their skills and focus on areas of weakness. Safe rifle manipulation will be engrained into the student.

TACTICAL PISTOL/RIFLE (3 Days)

This course will consist of two days pistol and an accelerated one day of rifle training. All pistol and rifle skills will be the same as the two-day modules.
