Tactical Rifle Instructor/Tactical Rifle Class

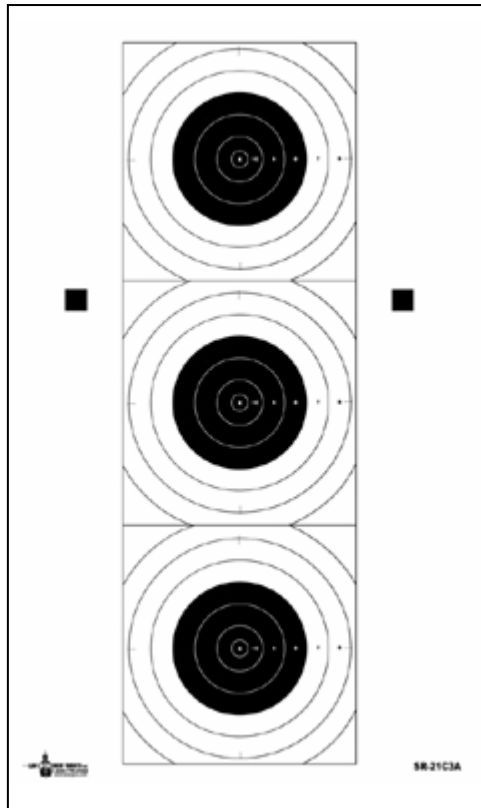
