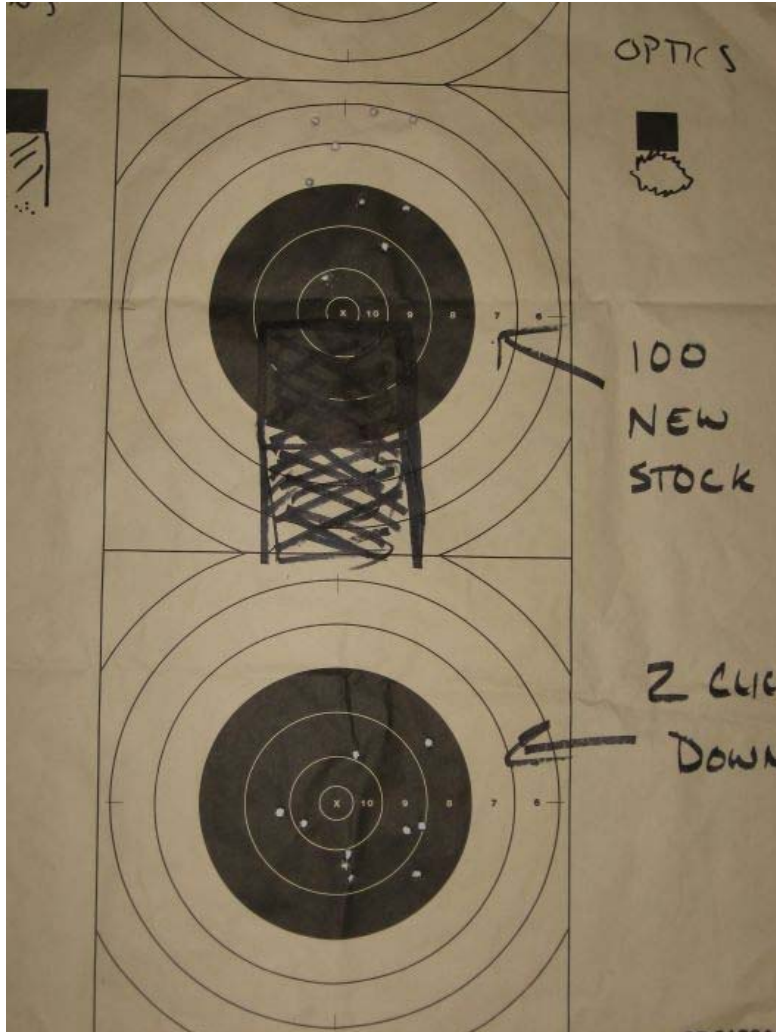

EQUIPMENT:

LWRC Rifle

The CSAT Rifle is closer to completion. We have decided to use the VTOR stock on the rifle as it is a bit more rugged and passed the drop test. We are still working on getting all the components together. I am also looking at an A2 style rear sight with my new sight blade on it. The current light is a Surefire Scout light.





I shot groups with the new stock and it changed my head/eye position and in turn changed my zero. Just a note to shooters to check your zero if you change something on the gun, especially in the head/eye relationship. Mine was off about 2-3" when I changed the stock. As a note, I don't usually preach a "center hold" when zeroing, but my eyes are starting to change and it is easier to use the center of bull for now...
