COURSE UPDATE(S):

We ran two **Long Range Hunter** classes this month back-to-back this month and the feedback has been great.

We recommend a mil-dot type scope with at least vertical ranging marks to get the most out of your weapon and training. We will have you shoot out to 600 yards using both dial in and hold off techniques.

Also, a small rucksack is helpful as we shoot of it up close and at distance. Any will do, but Tactical Tailor or Eagle makes nice ones with a shooting 'V' built into the top/back. This allows a shooter to simply lay it down and place the rifle in the notch..

Also, a bean bag for stock support will help a great deal. It can be filled with synthetic non-water absorbing beads from Hobby Lobby. Finally, Academy Sporting goods has exercise mats that go under exercise bikes and training machines that make great shooting mats and that are inexpensive and durable.

EQUIPMENT:

Pistol GAT www.xssights.com

There were many requests for the pistol GAT and XS Sights has built one. It slips on the Surefire X300 light and is held on with friction from two "O" rings. Placed in the 12 o'clock position on the light, it will fit into a Safariland 6004 holster with minor modification.

Similar to the rifle GAT, it is meant to be kept on the pistol and will work on car, door or window glass. I have broken out several car windows with it and the light remains securely on the pistol



The Pistol GAT simply attaches with the aid of two internal "O" rings.

A small pocket knife was used to cut a “V” into the plastic light stop plate of the holster which allows the tip to protrude slightly



The tip does not protrude enough to wear a hole in your seat or poke you. More testing is being conducted as we speak.
