

GENERAL INFORMATION:



We ran three classes last month back-to-back. I know I have sworn to “slow down,” but it was necessary to work a Basic SWAT to help calibrate the cadre. My intent is to pull back from that course a bit as the routine day is 12-14 hours long on the instructor side.

The Urban Marksman was full and went well. I asked an LE friend from the Iowa State Police to survey the course as a student to ensure it was covering all the needed material in a logical sequence. I do this from time to time to maintain the quality of the instruction. My friend is a Sniper Instructor and was a Scout Sniper in the U.S.M.C. He suggested that we add two courses to the curriculum, an Urban Marksman Rural Ops course and an Advance Urban Marksman. I would probably bring him in to co-teach it if I decide to add these courses because of all the moving parts.

The Tactical Medical Integration course was an eye opener and progressed as planned. I put Tac guys in charge of the student teams and they were instrumental in working through the tactical drills and scenarios. I wanted everyone to understand what priorities are in tactical and medical training and both sides adjusted well.

Finally, we just filmed a Tactical Drills DVD along with a Combat Mindset DVD which should be out in a couple of months.

Sometimes I believe our country needs an “In Service” training session on life, our history and direction.


Our country, good or bad is a “sink or swim” type of selection process for our people and those we assimilate.

Second victim dies in beating of elderly couple, as suspect could face more charges

An Oklahoma man suspected in a brutal home invasion -- already facing a murder charge for allegedly killing an elderly woman -- could face additional charges after the death last week of her husband, a D-Day veteran.

Bob Strait, a 90-year-old Tulsa resident, died on Friday, and a medical examiner is determining his cause of death, News On 6 reports.

He was injured March 13 when, police say, Tyrone Woodfork, 20, entered the house and attacked, allegedly beating and sexually assaulted Strait's 85-year-old wife, Nancy Strait, who died two days later. The couple had been married for 65 years.

Woodfork was arrested a day after the incident when he was spotted driving around in Strait's vehicle, a Tulsa Police Department spokesman told FoxNews.com.

Woodfork was booked into the Tulsa County Jail on March 15 and is being held on charges of first degree murder, first degree burglary, armed robbery and assault with a dangerous weapon.

Bob Strait was a World War II paratrooper who took part in the D-Day invasion as part of the 101st Airborne Division, where he was awarded a Bronze Star, News On 6 reports.

TRAINING:

Over the years I have had to release several students from CSAT classes for safety violations. As the owner and lead instructor it is important that I keep everyone safe, instructors, new students, visitors, etc.

It was necessary to release a student from my recent rifle instructor course for firing a live round from a pistol during dry fire practice on the firing line while showing a student how to perform a drill. His rifle was dry, his pistol was loaded. I asked him to leave as soon as it happened.

Everyone wants to carry loaded guns as instructors and this may cause you issues unless you keep a keen presence of mind while on the firing line. This is not the first time I have seen this happened and mentioned it to the instructor class during the week prior. This instructor will be allowed to come back and finish his block of instruction during another class to receive his certificate.

Another incident took place in the barracks and I was informed about ten day later by a student. Evidently a few instructor students were staying overnight along with

two day students and they were BSing in the lounge area. For some reason one of the instructor students drew his weapon and unloaded it and in the process flagged a two day student.

This violated two CSAT policies, one, flagging a student and the other unloading a weapon in the barracks. The instructor student was an LE officer from Florida and made light of the incident at the time and later apologized to the student. Since I found this out after the fact and everyone admitted to what had happened, the two day student was satisfied with the apology. I am not and the instructor student will not be allowed back at CSAT.

I will be changing the weapon policy at CSAT shortly and you will be in-briefed when you arrive. As for problems in the barracks, it is a convenience that I provide students which is sometimes a headache. If any further incidents happen, I will let students stay in hotels and turn that half of the building into a tanning salon.

Next, if a problem like that ever occurs, call me on my cell and I will come in and fix it. I will send a student packing in a heartbeat, money is not the priority, safety is. I can't do much when I find out ten days later. If it does not feel right, let me know and I will sort it out and make the hard calls. I do appreciate the student letting me know there was a problem.
