The revolver is seven shot, small, light and hammerless. It is simple to shoot, light recoil which is good to teach first time shooters and family members. It is reliable.

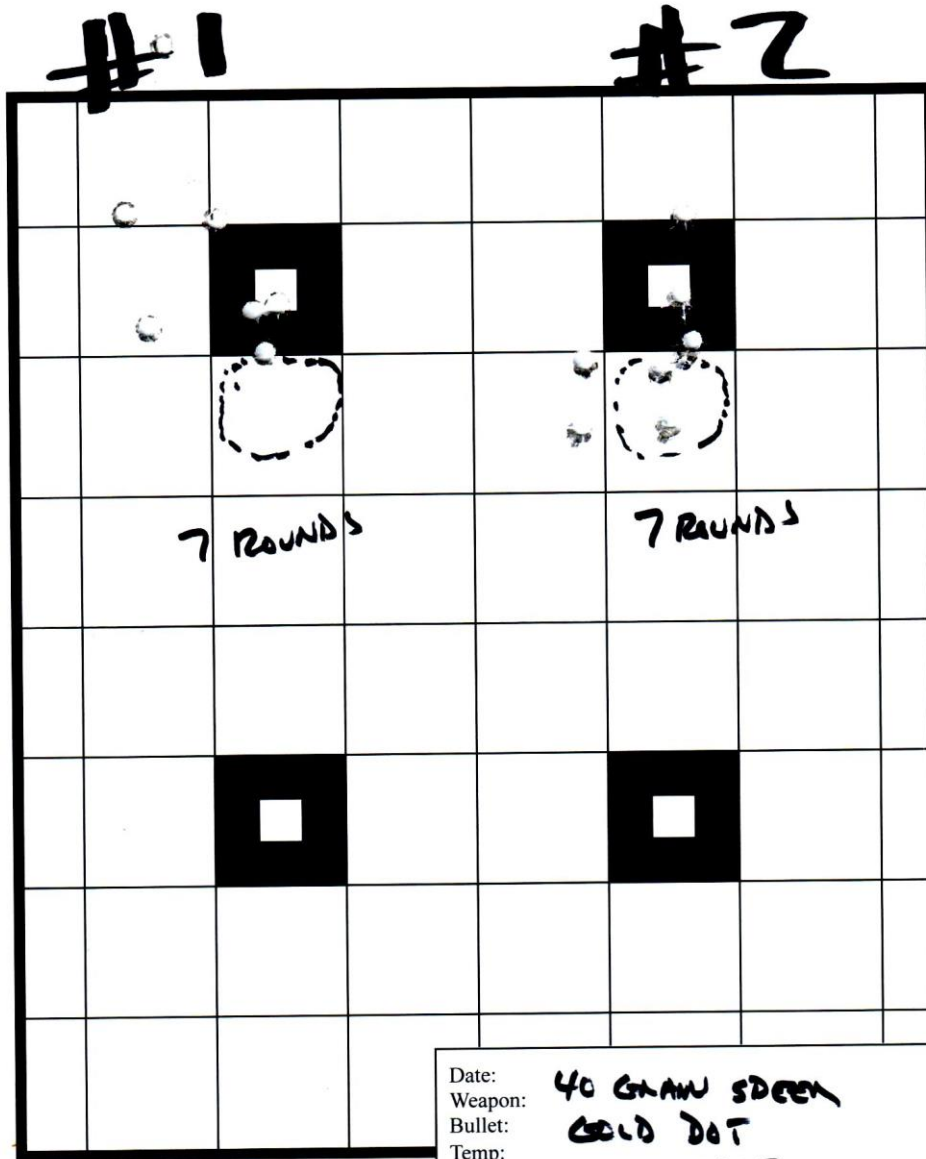
DUAL USE

The .22 WMR shot shells are a bit different.



At four yards with shot shells, I managed to get 8-10 pellets into the orbital areas.



At two-yards, it did a tight pattern, which is about the distance I dispatched the snake from.

DRAW BACKS

Barriers is the only thing I can see a problem with this caliber. I took the opportunity to shoot it through a windshield at a hostage target to see about deflection and any additional fragmentation.





The round stayed within the head when fired from front of the hood through the windshield. I would not recommend it on a hostage shot. If it were just one bad guy, I would deliver several through the same spot in hopes of getting one to solidly connect. Point of aim was between the eyes. More glass than usual rained back down on me.

Conclusion:

This package may work for you or it may not. I will use it as a back-up when I have a rifle in my hand and may put it through some scenario work both day and night in upcoming courses. I do like it as a light back up.
